Medium of Instruction

The medium of instruction shall be both English and Hindi. However, the examination will be conducted in English only.

APPLICATION FORM

The Prospectus and Application Form are available at the Admission Counter of the College for admission to various paramedical courses. The cost of the Prospectus and Application Form is ₹ 350/- Gen./₹ 300/- SC/ST only.

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM

- The application form must be carefully and completely filled.
- Incomplete or incorrectly filled application forms are liable to be rejected without any prior information.
- All required documents/certificates must be self-attested and attached with the application form.
- The duly completed application form should be submitted to the college on or before the last date as notified.
- The application may be submitted by hand, Registered Post, or Speed Post.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- Admissions are primarily conducted on the basis of the Jharkhand Combined Entrance Competitive Paramedical Examination (JCECEB), as applicable.
- In case of remaining vacant seats, admission may be granted through a written test and/or personality test, as decided by the institute.
- The list of selected candidates shall be displayed on the Notice Board of the Institute.
- Selected candidates will also be intimated by post.

At the time of admission, candidates are required to submit the following documents:

1. Xerox copy of certificate of the previous examination passed (10th or 12th).
2. Xerox copy of mark sheet of the previous examination passed.
3. Original School Leaving Certificate.
4. Original Migration/Transfer Certificate.

5. Caste Certificate (for SC/ST/OBC, if applicable).
6. Five (05) colour passport-size photographs with name printed on the photograph.

LIBRARY

IDENTITY CARD

- Every student is issued an Identity Card by Satyendra Narayan Sinha Institute of Allied Health Science at the commencement of their studies after registration.
- For students whose registration extends beyond one academic session, revalidation of the identity card is required at the beginning of each session.
- The identity card remains the property of the Institute and must be surrendered when the student ceases to be enrolled.
- Tampering with or misuse of the identity card is strictly prohibited.
- Students must produce the identity card whenever demanded by any authorized Institute staff.
- Students are required to carry the identity card during college hours and while accessing Institute facilities.
- No student shall be permitted to attend classes or enter the Institute premises without a valid identity card.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- All students must abide by the rules and regulations framed by Satyendra Narayan Sinha Institute of Allied Health Science from time to time.
- Applications for leave must be submitted in advance through the prescribed procedure.
- A minimum of 75% attendance is mandatory. Students failing to maintain the required attendance will not be permitted to appear in the final examination conducted by the Jharkhand State Paramedical Council, Ranchi.
- Continuous absence without prior permission may result in the student's name being struck off from the attendance register.
- If a student fails to pay fees regularly for three consecutive months, his/her name will be removed from the attendance register. A re-entry fee of ₹ 500/- will be charged for reinstatement.
- Fees once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
- Course fees must be deposited monthly or in instalments as prescribed by the Institute.
- All outstanding dues must be cleared before submission of the final examination form.
- Any damage to college property, toolkits, or equipment caused by students shall be recovered from the student/guardian.
- A student may be expelled from the Institute for misconduct, indiscipline, or non-payment of fees.
- Every student shall be bound by the rules and regulations formulated by the Management from time to time.
- Students entering the classroom or laboratory without the prescribed uniform will not be marked present.
- The final examination for all courses shall be conducted by the Jharkhand State Paramedical Council, Ranchi.
